

Visa service for visitors



Citizens from a number of countries require a visa to enter Germany. We would be pleased to assist you with a visa invitation letter to support your visa application.

Generally speaking, residents of countries in the EU **do not require** a visa to enter the Federal Republic of Germany.

In a directive transmitted per e-mail in July 2013, the German Foreign Office has informed the German Embassy and Consulate Visa Sections all over the world that in general, **an official invitation letter from the trade fair organizer is no longer required** when applying for a trade fair visa ([see website AUMA](#)). Moreover, visa fees are waived for exhibitors at German trade fairs ([see: website of the Federal Foreign Office](#)).

When applying for your visa, simply refer to this information. In case the visa section responsible for issuing your visa should nonetheless request that an official invitation letter be presented, please send an e-mail to: visaservice@messe-muenchen.de
